
The TJ3485 is a low-power half-duplex transceiver that meets the specifications of RS-485 and RS-422. IC contains one driver and one receiver. The driver slew rates is not limited, allowing them to transmit up to 5Mbps. These transceivers draw between 120uA and 500uA of supply current when unloaded or fully loaded with disabled drivers. All parts operate from a single 3.3V supply. Drivers are short-circuit current limited and are protected against excessive power dissipation by thermal shutdown circuitry that places the driver outputs into a high-impedance states. The receiver input has a fail-safe feature that guarantees a logic-high output if the input is open circuit. The ESD tolerance is more than $\pm 8 \text{kV}$ for both Human Body Model and $\pm 15 \text{kV}$ for IEC61000-4-2 Air Discharge Method on this device.



Pin Configuration and Logic Diagram



APPLICATION INFORMATION

FUNCTIONAL DESCRIPTION

The TJ3485 is half-duplex differential transceiver that meets the requirements of RS-485 and RS-422. The RS-485 standard is ideal for multi-drop applications and for long-distance interfaces. RS-485 allows up to 32 drivers and 32 receivers to be connected to a data bus, making it an ideal choice for multi-drop applications. Since the cabling can be as long as 4,000 feet, RS-485 transceivers are equipped with a wide (-7V to +12V) common mode range to accommodate ground potential differences. Because RS-485 is a differential interface, data is virtually immune to noise in the transmission line.

DRIVERS

The driver outputs of the TJ3485 are differential outputs meeting the RS-485 and RS-422 standards. The typical voltage output swing with no load will be 0 Volts to +3.3 Volts. With worst case loading of 54Ω across the differential outputs, the drivers can maintain greater than 0.8V voltage levels. The drivers of the TJ3485 have an enable control line which is active HIGH. A logic HIGH on DE (pin 3) will enable the differential driver outputs. A logic LOW on the DE(pin 3) will tri-state the driver output. The transmitters of the TJ3485 will operate up to at least 5Mbps.

RECEIVERS

The TJ3485 receiver has differential inputs with an input sensitivity as low as ± 200 mV. Input impedance of the receivers is greater than $12k\Omega$. A wide common mode range of -7V to +12V allows for large ground potential differences between systems. The receivers of the TJ3485 have a tri-state enable control pin. A logic LOW on RE* (pin 2) will enable the receiver, a logic HIGH on RE*(pin 2) will disable the receiver The receiver for the TJ3485 will operate up to at least 5Mbps. The receiver is equipped with the fail-safe feature. Fail-safe guarantees that the receiver output will be in a HIGH state when the input is left unconnected.
